1. Construction Leader Qualities

3. Team Leaders

Successful team leaders build effective teams through an understanding of performance styles.

4. Leadership is Hard

Experienced leaders understand the power of conflict and motivation. This module will look at motivation, demotivation and how to promote employee accountability.

5. The Great Leader

The great leader isolates and identifies the root problems of poor performance. This module also looks at the power of praise to increase team enthusiasm.
