1. Project Setup Through Closeout

Discover typical construction project workflows. The contractor-subcontractor relationship, including proper communication. Learn typical checklist items used in setting up projects. Discover 7 steps to a successful project closeout, Learn critical steps to completing a typical construction project with a useable checklist, including tips, and suggestions to maximize checklist use. Managing the change order process.

2. Production, Leadership and Project Delivery

Explore the supervisor's role in successful project delivery. Learn the definition of productivity and how to benchmark

productivity. Look at the relationships between leadership, project delivery, and productivity.

3. Delivering a Profitable Project

Examine a project's cost basis while looking at it from a supervisor's and a project manager's viewpoint. Learn the primary costs in a typical project and their origins in the estimate. Discuss drivers which have direct impact on the cost.

4. Improving Project Delivery

Using scheduling, costs, and field management, learn how the supervisor's management and leadership skills become key in productivity improvement. Discover the differences between bringing a project in under budget, at budget, and over budget through basic productivity analysis.
